ROBUST IMPACT ASSESSMENTS

Practical Experiences from RegWatchEurope Members

According to RegWatchEurope's experiences, the following aspects have been proven successful in order to ensure robust impact assessments (in addition to independent scrutiny):

- (1) A **Simple and standardized methodology**, where possible, for all impact assessments ensures consistent application and comparability of results.
- (2) In order to ensure comprehensive impact assessments, **full transparency and quantification regarding all direct impacts** should be an obligation for all impact assessments if meaningful, given that all impact assessments cannot be quantified in a worthwhile way.

- (3) All underlying assumptions and models must be accessible to the public.
- (4) Stakeholders should be consulted at the drafting stage of impact assessments in order to compare the assessments and underlying assumptions of draft impact assessments with experiences and information gained in practice;
- (5) In order to ensure that all legislative drafts are accompanied by an impact assessment, the principle of proportionality has proven successful to avoid a disproportionate amount of work on proposals with very limited impacts.
